Championnat ouvert d'échecs de la Francophonie (Open and Amateur)

- Eligibility : players coming from AIDEF Federations (Canadian players are eligible).
- Online registration or by mail : FQE, 4545 Pierre-de Coubertin, Montréal H1V 0B2
- Registration : No refund after July 1st 2015. 15% administrative fees in case of cancellation.
- 10th Tournament of Tour du Québec Grand prix 2014-15.
- Players must be CFC or FQE members.
- Byes (½ point) : 2 possible byes in the first four rounds if taken before the tournament.
- Ratings used for Canadian players (in this order, except for Quebec players) : FIDE, CFC.
- Chess set are provided. Bring clocks.
- Touch-move rule enforced.
- Players must write down their moves at all time.
- Appeals possible following a deposit of \$50.
- No appeals on the pairings.
